

MAHANA SCHOOL PROCEDURE

DEALING WITH HEPATITIS OR HIV/AIDS

- Any disclosure from individuals regarding Hepatitis, HIV/AIDS must be recorded in writing and securely held by the school to maintain the strictest confidence.
- To prevent cross infection, particularly when dealing with blood flow related injuries, each First Aid kit must contain barrier **gloves, which will be worn** by any person treating such an injury. Also, the face shields provided should be used if mouth-to-mouth ventilation were needed.
- The issues of Hepatitis or HIV/AIDS are discussed and questions answered in an appropriate manner within the school's health programme. Children must be kept up to date with the dangers of blood borne diseases.
- This procedure is to be discussed by Staff and Board of Trustees annually, to ensure a continuing awareness.
