

# MAHANA SCHOOL PROCEDURE

## VANDALISM

### Implementation:

- The Principal will act immediately to gather information. Witnesses to the act be interviewed
- At the Principal's discretion, the police may be notified depending on the severity of the act.
- If the perpetrator is a Mahana School student, the restorative justice process will be followed. This may include parents / whanau.
- The Board will be informed as soon as possible about any significant vandalism and resulting action.
- As part of the Restorative Practice process, repair costs or community service will be required. If both parties (the principal and perpetrator) are not in agreement the matter will be referred to the police for further action.
- Significant acts of vandalism and the actions taken will be advised to the school community.
